Maawe, Sworn. I know his land in the Ahupuaa of Kalulu, Lanai. 1 Parcel of land.

A moku mauu (grass land/pasture section), and a house in the Ili of lomo.

The boundaries are thus. Mauka, land of Konohiki. Kamaiki, land of Laupahulu. Makai, land of Konohiki. Kaena, Ahupuaa of Maunalei.

He received this parcel of land from his parents in the time of Kamehameha I, and has held it peaceably to this time. No one has objected.
