These people whose names are above, have abandoned their Claims on the *kula* of Kaholo, because they have nothing planted there, not even a little area planted, it is open only. A field for tending *kao* (goats), and rightly for the *Konohiki*. For it is only a *kula* (plain, or open field) on the land.
