Kaena, a cliff.

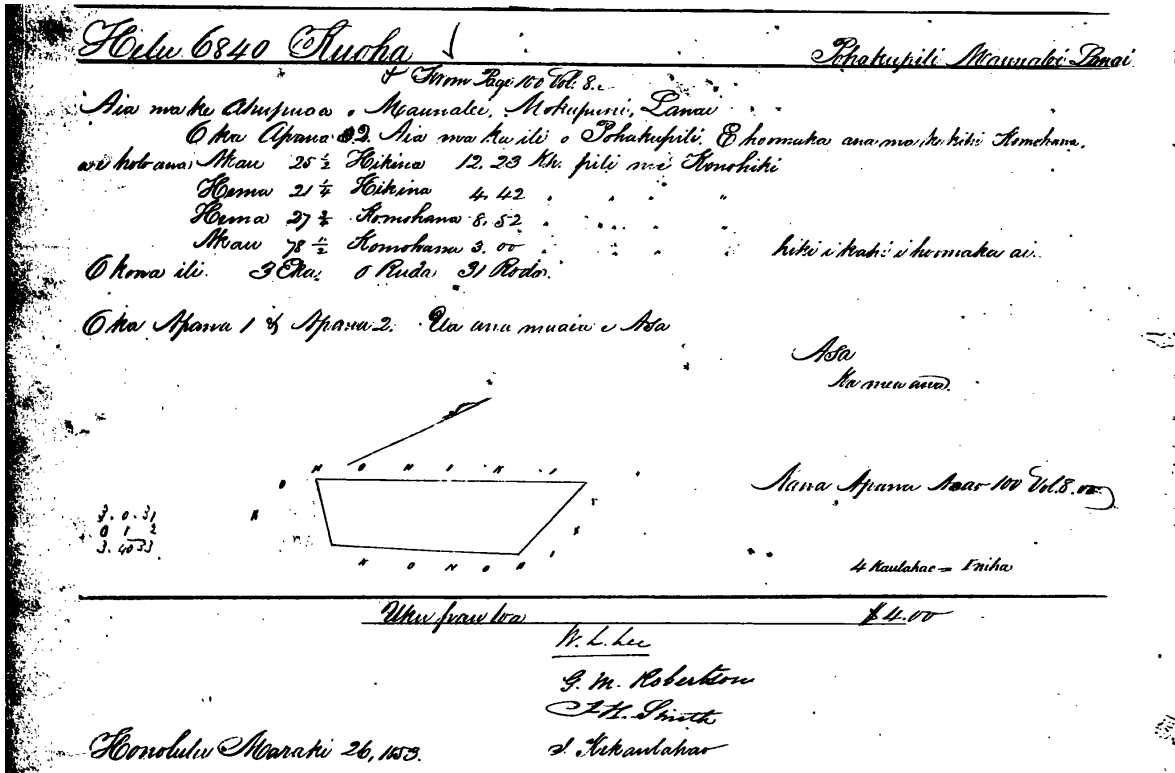
Parcel 2. The boundaries are thus. *Mauka*, land of *Kaleo*. *Kamaiki*, a cliff. *Makai* and around,


