Greetings to you Commissioners who Quiet Land Titles. We make an application for our lands: lots, enclosed lands, house lots, *pauku*-sections of lands, single and multiple *loi* (taro pond fields), single and multiple *moo* (narrow dry land sections), houses, some *loi*, *kula* (dry land fields) (*kula*), *uala* (sweet potato) patches, and trees that have been planted.
