In Confirmation of Land Commission Award.

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners to quiet Land Titles,  
did, by their decision, award by Land Commission Award No. 7714-B/1 to  
MOSE KEKUA'IWA NO M. KEKUANAOA

an estate OF FREEHOLD LESS THAN ALLodial in the land hereinafter  
described, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Commissioner of  
Public Lands by HAWAIIAN PINEAPPLE COMPANY, LIMITED,  
the present owner of said land for a Patent covering same, and

WHEREAS, this award was made by name only and a Certificate of Boundary, numbered 35, containing a description of Survey defining the boundaries thereof, has been filed with the Commissioner of Public Lands, and

WHEREAS, the Government Commutation was released by resolution of the Privy Council, dated Aug. 27, 1850, for the surrender by him of lands in lieu thereof, as mentioned on page 408 of volume 2 of record of Foreign Testimony,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, in conformity with the laws of the United States of America and of the Territory of Hawaii, by this Patent makes known to all men that he has this day granted and confirmed absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto

MOSE KEKUA'IWA NO M. KEKUANAOA

all of the land situate at Kaohai  
in the District of Island of Lanai bounded  
and described as follows:

Commencing at a red wood post (The same being the point of Commencement of Paawili survey) on the South East side of a small inlet of the Sea at a place called Halekaloa, the boundary runs:

1. S. 56° 46' W. true 6464.4 feet, along Paawili up gulch to a rock a little above head of same marked with a cross;
2. S. 71° 59' W. true 8489 feet along Paawili to a red wood post on a hill at the North West edge of a gulch;
3. Thence following (along Paawili) up bottom of above mentioned gulch to a point at head of same; which point bears S 75° 25' W. true 5342 feet from the above red wood post on hill;
4. N. 76° 50' W. true 1000 feet along Paawili across top of mountain to a concrete post at a place called "Haalele Paakai". Thence
5. S. 41° 57' W. true 1290 feet along Palawai down ridge to top of a red hill. Thence
