Parcel 2. 1 cultivated section in the *ili* of "Kuahua."

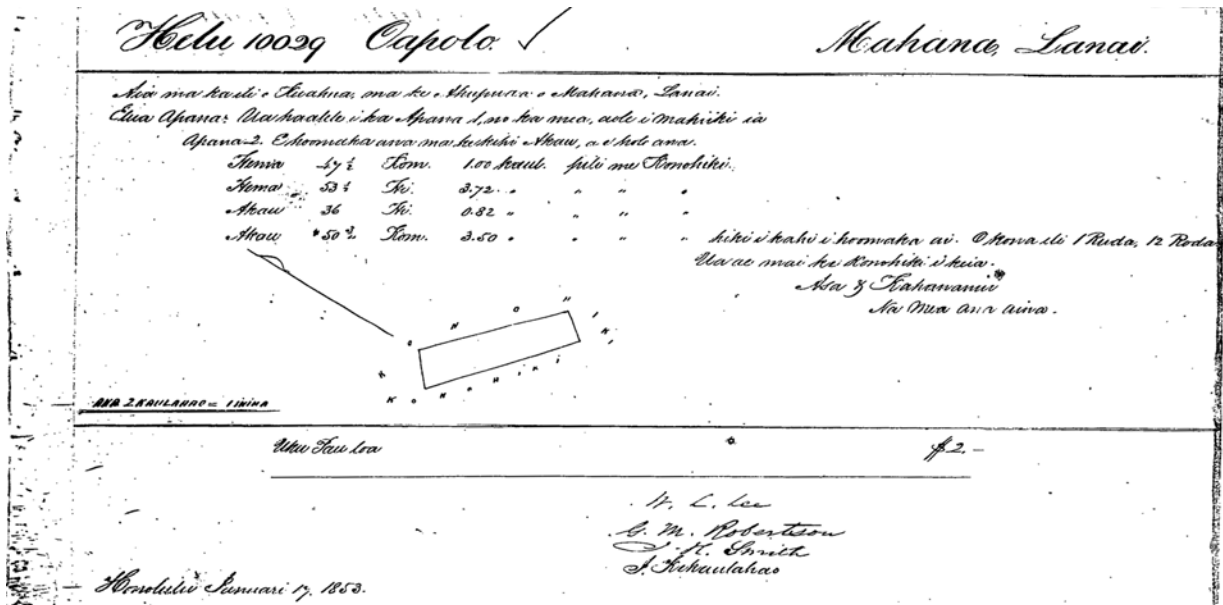
