Pohano, Sworn. My claim for *loi* (taro pond field) land is at Maunalei, Lanai. I rightfully returned it to the *Konoheiki*, because I abandoned it. My house lot claim is also under the *Konoheiki*.

My land claim at Mahana, Lanai is my claim which you should know, and it is there that I live.

Kukololoua, Sworn. I know his Parcels of land at Mahana, Lanai. 1 Parcel of land.

2 *Pauku* aina (land sections) of sweet potato and *mahakea* (fallow land) at Kahokunui.

The boundaries are thus. *Mauka*, land of *Konoheiki*. *Kaena*, the same. *Makai*, land of Waimalu. *Kamaiki*, land of *Konoheiki*.

He received this parcel of land from his parents in the time of Kamehameha I, and has resided there peaceably to this time. No one has objected.

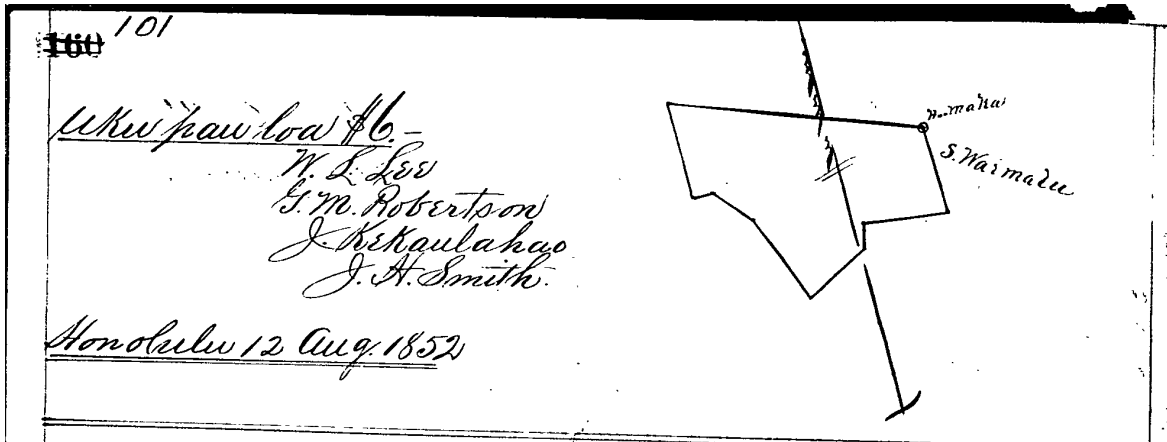

the present owner of said land for a Patent covering same, and

file in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Lands, and

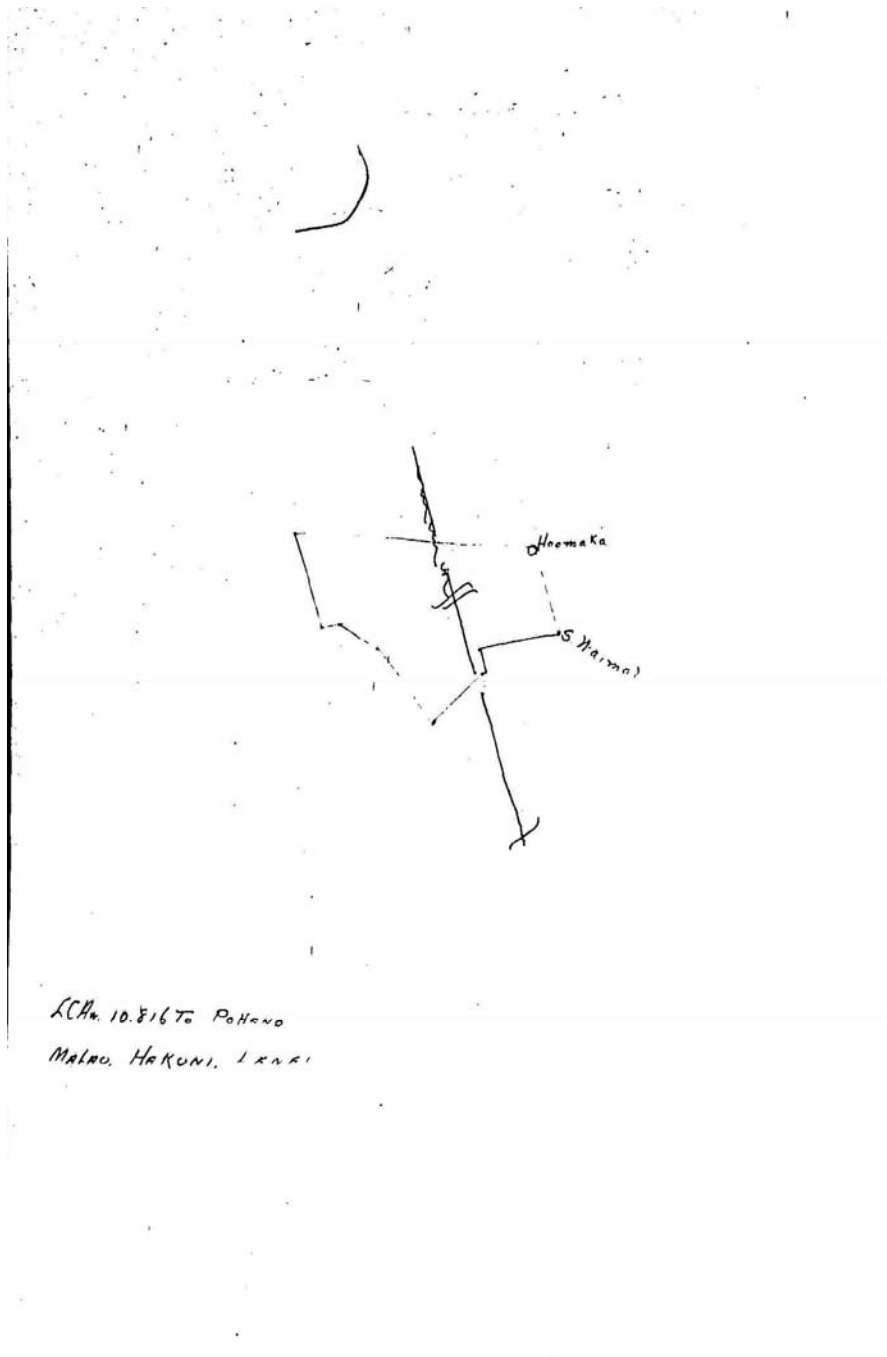
WHEREAS, there is no Government Commutation due thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, the ^{ACTING} Governor of the Territory of Hawaii,
